Dear Ms. Bose:

On August 25, 2017, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC” or “Commission”) issued an Order Issuing Certificates and Approving Abandonment (“August 25 Order”) in the above referenced docket granting NEXUS Gas Transmission, LLC (“NEXUS”), amongst other authorizations, a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate the NEXUS Project.<sup>1</sup> On September 11, 2017, NEXUS filed a letter with the Commission accepting the August 25 Order. Pursuant to Environmental Condition No. 6 of the August 25 Order, NEXUS hereby submits its Implementation Plan for the NEXUS Project for review by the Director of the Office of Energy Projects (“Director”).

The Implementation Plan provides a description of proposed measures that NEXUS will take to comply with certain environmental conditions applicable to the NEXUS Project. For those environmental conditions that apply only to Texas Eastern Transmission, LP’s Appalachian Lease Project, NEXUS has indicated “not applicable.” NEXUS respectfully requests that the Director review the proposed measures for compliance with the conditions that have been fully addressed as part of the Implementation Plan.

The Implementation Plan included herewith contains four volumes. Volume I includes the public version of the Implementation Plan and its appendices. Volume II contains the public maps and alignment sheets. Volume III contains privileged landowner information and sensitive cultural resources information and is marked “**CONTAINS PRIVILEGED INFORMATION – DO NOT RELEASE**”<sup>2</sup> and “**CUI//PRIV.**”<sup>3</sup> Privileged information should be treated as confidential and is for use by Commission Staff only and not to be released to the public. Volume IV contains Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (plot plans) and is marked **CONTAINS CRITICAL ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE INFORMATION – DO NOT RELEASE,**<sup>4</sup> and “**CUI//CEII.**” Information that is CEII should be treated as confidential
